



The history of skiing in Shiga Kogen started in 1913 when Mr. and Mrs. Kimmel brought skis to Kanbayashi Hot Spring. After that, skiing gained popularity, especially among the youth, and resulted in the establishment of the Shinshu Yamanouchi Ski Club in 1920. In 1928, the club held a Shin-estu ski competition along with other ski clubs from Niigata and Gunma Prefectures. In 1929, Mr. Helzette and a group from Norway visited Shiga Kogen, and skied that point, the area underwent rapid development, including the creation of the current Giant of people leading the development at the time. The Shinshu Yamanouchi Ski Club later became Shiga Kogen Ski Club, is primarily involved with activities such as educating athletes and instruc-

tors, holding competitions, and running a ski school, and continues to produce many high level winter sports athletes. In the 1970s, when an unprecedented ski boom was the rage throughout Japan, the community as well as the local government offered to host a range of sporting events, including national athletic meets, national competitions, and World Cups. After wowing all those who took part in such events, Shiga Kogen was appointed as one of the sites for the Nagano 1998 Olympic Winter Games: giant slalom events or alpine skiing at Higashitateyama ski resort,
